

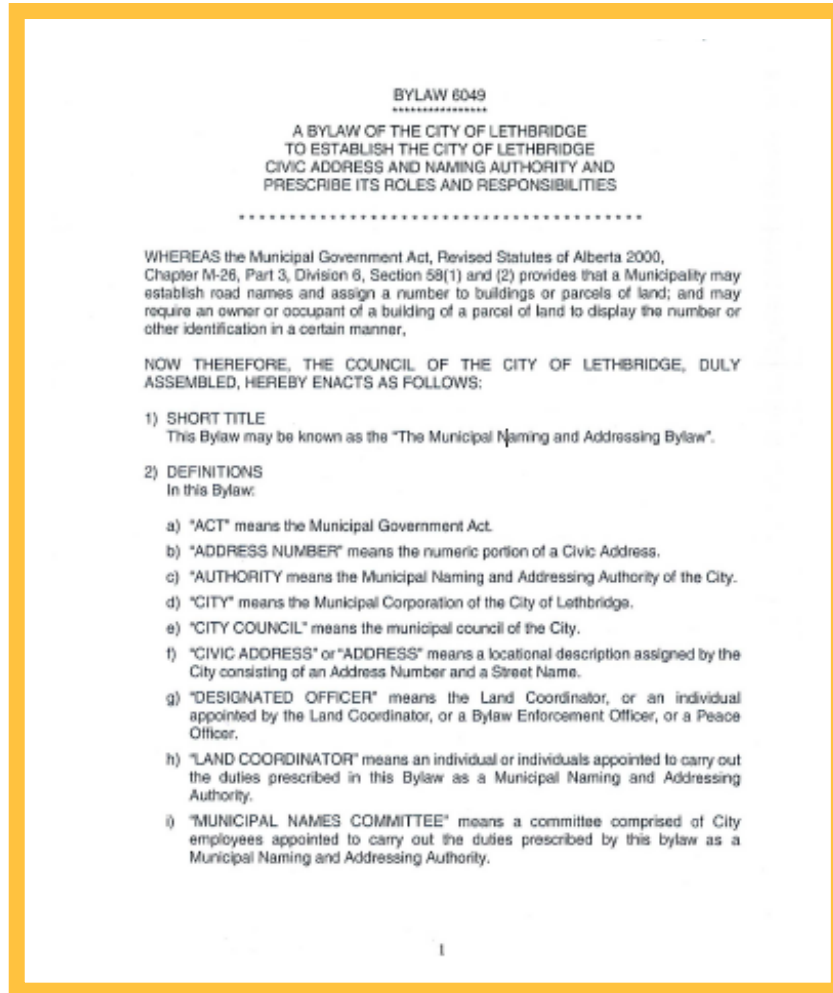

- Latest amendment to Bylaw 6049
 - April 2017
- Why are we repealing and replacing the Bylaw now?
 - Create a consistent process for the naming and renaming of City Assets
 - Align with the Sponsorship, Naming Rights & Advertising Policy
 - Clarify Council's authority to rename municipal assets

Bylaw 6508

- What changes are being proposed?
 - Removes references to the Land Coordinator
 - Streamlines addressing process
 - Expands violation sections
- Engagement:
 - Councils Status of Directed Resolutions, Municipal Names Committee and Executive Leadership Team
- Impacts
 - Creates consistency and guidance for Staff and public
 - Development of accompanying policy and procedure
