

BYLAW 6407

A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF LETHBRIDGE TO AMEND
BYLAW 6296 – CLEAN ENERGY IMPROVEMENT TAX BYLAW

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Lethbridge enacted Bylaw 6296 – Clean Energy Improvement Tax Bylaw to establish a Clean Energy Improvement Program;

AND WHEREAS the Program is a financing program that facilitates the construction and installation of Eligible Clean Energy Improvements for Owners of Eligible Properties;

AND WHEREAS due to overwhelming demand for the Program, the City of Lethbridge wishes to accelerate the availability of funding for the Program so Owners may have more immediate access to the Program;

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LETHBRIDGE, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, DULY ASSEMBLED, HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Bylaw 6296 – Clean Energy Improvement Tax Bylaw is amended.
2. Bylaw 6296 is amended as follows:
 - (a) in Part V, subsection 5(1), by deleting the second sentence and replacing with the following:

“In the case of multiple improvements to a single Eligible Property, the period over which the total cost of the improvements will be spread will be determined for each improvement, and if the improvements’ probable lifetimes are different, there will be a different Agreement for each improvement.”
 - and,
 - (b) by deleting subsection 5(5) in its entirety and replacing with the following:

“The maximum funding amount to be allocated to the Program, subject to the CAO’s sole discretion to allocate less, is \$3,800,000 (THREE MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS), over a 4 (FOUR) year period.”.

3. This Bylaw comes into force and effect on third and final reading.
